OTTAWA VALLEY MOBILE RADIO CLUB POT HOLE NET PROCEDURE

Originated May 1959

Dear OM:

Past practice has shown that it is beneficial for the Net Control Station to initiate contact with another station at 0950 to 0955 mentioning the "Net" at 1000 hrs to ensure that the frequency will be available sharp at the appointed hour. In the event that you find it impossible to meet this schedule contact the Net Manager or one of the club executives so that a substitute can be arranged.

The following format is suggested for the conduct of the net. It is not mandatory but by using it the Net will sound more businesslike and uniform. Net Time is 1000 hrs local time every Saturday and Sunday on 3760 kcs.

"THIS IS (your call) NET CONTROL STATION FOR THE OTTAWA VALLEY MOBILE RADIO CLUB POT HOLE NET FOR (date) . THIS NET MEETS TWICE WEEKLY ON 3760 KCS AT 1000 HRS LOCAL TIME EVERY SATURDAY AND SUNDAY . FOLLOWS NOW A TEN SECOND UNMODULATED CARRIER FOR ZERO BEATING PURPOSES. PLEASE ZERO-BEAT THIS FREQUENCY. 10 second unmodulated carrier)

THE PURPOSE OF THIS NET IS TO ANNOUNCE FORTHCOMING ACTIVITIES OF THE OTTAWA VALLEY MOBILE RADIO CLUB, PERTINENT BULLETINS OF THE ARRL AND TO PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY FOR THE MEMBERS TO ARRANGE IMPROMPTU TECHNICAL AND SOCIAL ACTIVITIES. THERE WILL NOW BE A ROLE CALL, FOLLOWED BY THE ANNOUNCEMENTS AND AN INFORMAL RAG CHEW.

(Please use up-to-date membership list or other agreed list as role call)
After role call: "ARE THERE ANY STATIONS WISHING TO CHECK OUT OF THE NET?
THIS IS (your call) NET CONTROL STATION FOR THE OTTAWA VALLEY MOBILE RADIO
CLUB POT HOLE NET. ARE THERE ANY OTHER STATIONS WISHING TO CALL IN?
PLEASE DO SO NOW AND ALL STATIONS PLEASE COPY.

(After all stations have called in the net control station should turn it over to the Activities Director for his announcements of Club activities and ARRL bulletins.

The net control station (or delegated substitute) should maintain control of the Rag Chew portion and call in all stations that checked in as a result of the role call.

After the rag chew the Net Control Station should take one final check for any other stations wishing to check in, then sign the Net.

OPERATING HINTS

For obvious reasons mobile stations should have preference over fixed stations at all times.

Full call signs should be used at all times e.g. VE3RAM not 3RAM

VE3CGO is keeping a record of the Net Control Stations and stations who check into the Net. Please ascertain at the end of the Net if she has the list of calls.
