CALL LETTER LICENCE PLATES FOR ONTARIO --- AT LONG LAST!

You may recall that our Club was very active in the battle to obtain call letter licence plates under the chairmanship of Jack VE3YC. We almost had them on the ropes when RSO requested the Club to turn over all the data to them so that they could continue the fight. This was prior to 1967 and unfortunately RSO did a very poor job of carrying on the battle and dropped the ball much to our chagrin. In 1975 renewed efforts by individual Radio Amateurs and RSO resulted in Ontario at last obtaining the privilege. Ontario had the dubious distinction of being the last province in Canada to grant the plates. All U.S. States have had them for some time. The following was received on 75 from Lorne VE3SZ:

The Ministry of Transport and Communication announced today April 1st 1976 the process to follow to obtain call sign licence plates for passenger vehicles, that is, those vehicles now carrying plates with 3 letter three number plates. All that is required is a letter of application accompanied by a cheque for \$25.00 payable to Treasurer of Ontario. Application should show full name of applicant, address and VE3 call sign. They should be addressed to The Ministry of Transportation and Communication, Queens Park, Toronto Ontario, Attention Miss E. Graham. Instructions on what to do on receipt of plates will be sent with the plates. Any queries should be directed to Miss Graham. Note:Lorne suggested that it might be a good idea to indicate your present vehicle licence on your application.
