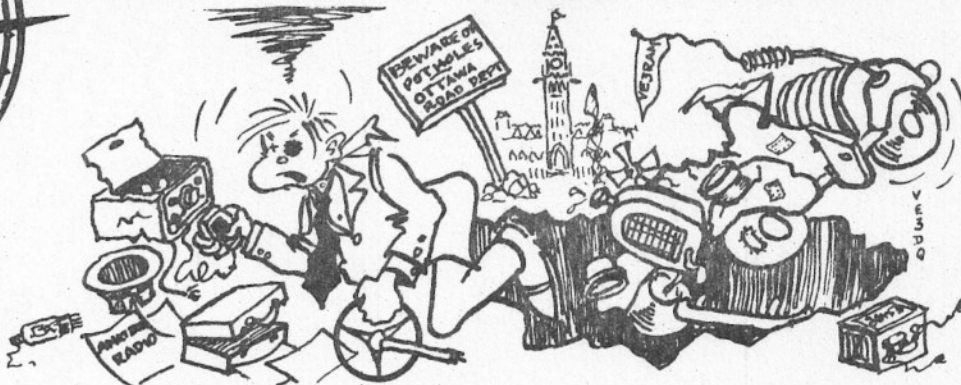

REPORT ON THE LAST MEETING

Merv VE3CV ably chaired a discussion on the DOC proposals for two new classes of Amateur Radio licences. After a general discussion period the members were asked to vote on the proposals. The results are indicated hereunder.

Experimenter Class no code Licence: 29 members were against this proposal. None for.

Novice Class 5 wpm no fone Licence: 27 members were against this proposal. 2 were for.

It should be noted that there was one abstention in each of the two votes. From the discussion it was evident that the majority of the members present were of the opinion that the present licencing regulations are entirely adequate and that anyone genuinely interested in becoming an Radio Amateur could do so in a short time and thereby

ensure the healthy continuation of the hobby. The meeting also decided that a letter outlining the Club position be sent to Mr. W.W. Scott, Director of Operations Branch, DOC Telecommunications Regulatory Service. A letter dated 28 September 1976 was duly submitted and an acknowledgement has since been received by the President of our Club. Info copies of our letter were sent to CARF, RSO, CRRL and Art Stark VE3ZS.

Editorial Comment: From what I have heard it seems that many Radio Amateurs are in favor of a Novice Class of Licence and that this will be conveyed to the department by various individuals and Canadian organizations. I predict that it will come to pass. I am concerned however that those in favor of this class have not considered the question in depth, and the impact it will have on present, as well as future generations of Radio Amateurs. Unless proper safeguards are built-in, and what is more important, enforced, we will have a situation tantamount to CB or GRS, which as we all know is completely out of control. What is worse many CBers are becoming Radio Amateurs. Good news! because it will increase our ranks! Bad news! because many of them will bring with them their total lack of respect for the Radio Act and the DOC, as well as for their fellow hobbyists. In conclusion, let me say this: "DOC, CRRL, CARF, RSO and individuals PLEASE think and re-think, and look into the future before rushing into the implementation of the Novice Class. HAN IMPROPERLY CONCEIVED AND IMPLEMENTED NOVICE CLASS WITHOUT PROPER SAFEGUARDS IS TOO HORRENDOUS TO CONTEMPLATE! If you lack imagination in this area I would be glad to elucidate.
