Ron North VE3HDO, the retiring President reviewed the Club activites and achievements during his 1977 tenure of office as follows:

1977 CLUB ACTIVITIES & ACHIEVEMENTS

- 30 April 77: Sponsored and organized the Amateur Radio Spring Auction held at EMO HQ. The most successful acution in terms of Club profit in several years.
- 7 May 77: Provided communications for the Metres(Miles) For Millions Walk for the 11th consecutive year! \$200,000.00 was raised for charity. 31 Ottawa area Radio Amateurs participated to provided continuous communications for 16 hrs 30 min
- Club purchased a 2 meter repeater from VE3ARS, which is operating from a temporary location with the call sign VE3TWO 147.90 input 147.30 output. It is hoped that a suitable location can be found in the near future which will extend the range in the eastern part of the city.
- 25/26 June 77: Club participated in Field Day. Total of 863 contacts for a score of 2,852 We came 3rd in Ontario and 5th in Canada in our 2 transmitter class.
- 18 Nov 77: Held a very successful Club Dinner to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the founding of our Club.
- 26 Nov 77: Club was represented at the Amateur Radio Symposium "Amateur Radio in the 1980's" held in the Conference Center in Ottawa.

NOTICE OF MOTION

Tan VE3FKC noted that Club operating costs are increasing and that the Club Full and Associate membership dues have remained at \$5.00 for many years despite the fact that salaries have increased in keeping with the cost of living over the same period. He therefore advised that he (or his proxy) intends to make a motion at the January meeting to amend the constitution to increase the membership dues from \$5.00 per year to \$7.00 per year for FULL, ASSOCIATE and RESTRICTED classes of membership. FAMILY (dependent of member) and DX (former member who has moved away from area) dues to remain \$1.00 and \$2.00 respectively.
