

# 2013 LARRY WILCOX MEMORIAL 2M FM SIMPLEX CONTEST

At least 13 amateurs participated in the 2013 Larry Wilcox Memorial 2 metre FM simplex contest. These included VA2MA, VA2RWN, VE3AAQ, VE3EJJ, VE3EKN, VE3EMB, VE3EUS, VE3GBD, VE3TVS, VE3KNE, VE3MYR, VE3NPO and VE3MYZ.

Six of these amateurs submitted log sheets.

Of those six, two operated as fixed stations and four as rovers. There were no portable stations this year. Mobile stations were not allowed to participate.

Travis VE3TVS operated the club fixed station VE3JW. James VE3MYZ operated the club rover station VE3RAM.

There were at least 152 contacts attempted.

Of the contacts attempted, 144 resulted in valid QSO's.
